

Club Bingo House Policy

Under the NSW Lotteries and Art Unions Act 1901 and Regulation 2014

1. Club Bingo is conducted to promote patronage of a Registered Club by its Members and Guests.
2. Club Bingo cannot be conducted on weekends – between 6pm on a Friday and midnight the following Sunday.
3. Total value of all prizes in any one game cannot exceed \$70. A single prize in a game cannot exceed \$40.
4. Cash prizes are not permitted. Vouchers for goods and services are acceptable prizes.
5. Jackpotting of prizes is not allowed.
6. A combined maximum of paper and electronic books that can be purchased is 8 per player.
7. No person conducting or assisting in the conduct of the game can participate as a player.

Doyalson Wyee RSL Club Bingo Rules

8. All players must be a financial member of the Doyalson Wyee RSL Club or signed into the club as either a guest of a Member or a Visitor
9. Players are to remain in the dedicated room throughout the Bingo session to be eligible to play bingo. Players are only permitted to play Books/Pets purchased for their personal use with a limit of 1 Pet per player.
10. For members of the club Prizes will be awarded in different dominations of points, which equal the \$30 prize value.
11. For non members of the club, Prizes will be awarded in Doylo vouchers, which equal a \$20 prize value.
12. Winners are required to show their membership card and sign as acceptance of their prize.
13. In the event of more than one winner in a game of club bingo, the prize is to be share between the winners.
14. It is the responsibility of each player to check that they have the correct books and change before leaving the sales table. No Responsibility will be taken once you have left.
15. To be deemed a winner player will have a "Full House". Exceptions are in "Undercover" and "Tear Off" games.
16. Once the caller has called a game closed, no other cards will be accepted as winning cards. If there is more than one winner the prize will be shared equally.
17. Any books purchased in a session must be played in that session only, books from a previous session will not be accepted.
18. Player must have the last number called when calling Bingo.
19. It is the player's responsibility to call out loud enough for the caller to hear, fail to do so will result in the prize not being paid.
20. A number is not fully called until the number has been repeated.
21. If a caller makes an incorrect call, the caller shall then deem the number called as out.
22. To be deemed a winner, players must be playing the correct book and card colour with the correct serial number (PET consoles will have to have the correct serial number).
23. Callers will verify that the winner/s is playing the correct game via a call-back. If it is incorrect the prize will not be paid.
24. School age children are permitted to play Club Bingo however they must remain seated with an accompanying adult at all times. If a child wins a prize, the prize will only be paid to the accompanying adult.
25. All players must remain quiet during the calling of the Bingo numbers. Any unnecessary disruptions including abusive and aggressive behaviour towards staff members during Bingo will not be tolerated and will result in the player being asked to leave and a ban on playing Club Bingo may be imposed.
26. All mobile phones must be switched to Silent or Turned Off during Bingo.
27. The Bingo Caller will have the final say on any disputes arising during a session.
